
GB & England: Least Concern VC5 Scarce; VC6 Scarce

An annual grass of paths, lawn edges and open grassland, historically only found in coastal clifftop grasslands. Flowering very early in the year, its small, yellowish, erect culms are distinctive only in early spring. This species is a recent addition to the Somerset flora, first found by Paul Green on the sea lawns of Weston-super-Mare (VC6) in 2004. In VC5, found for the first time in 2007 by Jeanne Webb, in Minehead. A second population was found by Stephen Parker in 2012 at Minehead Golf Course and in 2014 he discovered this species on a roadside in Bagley Green, near Wellington. In 2017 Matt Stribley found it along path edges at a campsite in Porlock. In VC6, a second site was found in 2007 in Wells, by Paul Stanley. In 2008 plants were found in Burnham-on-Sea by Robert Cropper and at Batheaston by Mark Kitchen. In 2012 Clive Lovatt discovered another site at the northbound side of Sedgemoor Services on the M5; in 2014 Paul Green found it there on the southbound side and Clive Lovatt discovered it at Gordano Services, further north up the M5. In 2015 it was found at Bristol Airport by Paul Green and in a roadside planter in Bath by Rob Randall. This species has increased its range remarkably in recent years. It was first found in Cornwall in 1876, then not seen again until 1950, when it was found in Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly (Hubbard, 1984). By 2000, it had appeared at many sites along the south coast and has subsequently spread around the coast and inland. Sites in Somerset are within the area of recent colonisation.
