A perennial herb of usually damp grassland habitats and mountain ledges. There is a specimen at **E** collected in 1837 by R.C. Alexander (det. S.M. Walters) from "near Bath". This is the only record for Somerset. This species is absent from most of southern England and has suffered losses from sites at the southern edge of its range (M.J. Wiggington in Preston *et al.*, 2002). The site near Bath was its most south-westerly known location.
