
Euphrasia confusa Pugsley x tetraquetra (Bréb.) Arrond.

Native

VC5 Rare; VC6 Scarce

A variable, low-growing hybrid of cliff-tops, stabilised dunes, and calcareous grassland, differing from *E. tetraquetra* in its greater profusion of branches, which bear very small leaves, the leaves more cuneate with longer, finer teeth (Stace, 1975). In VC5 found in 2018 by G. Lavender and R. FitzGerald at Shurton Bars near Hinckley Point, growing with E. tetraguetra, the identification confirmed by Chris Metherell. There have been several records for VC6. Specimens in BM determined by P.F. Yeo were collected from Berrow [ST25] in 1900, Worle [ST36] by E.S. Marshall in 1907, Burnham [ST34] by T.J. Foggitt in 1931 and A.E. Wade in 1939, and Cheddar Gorge [ST467544] by P.F. Yeo in 1953. A specimen found by C.A. Howe at Pitcombe [ST63] in 1966 was identified as this hybrid by P.F. Yeo, although this is far outside the current known range of E. tetraquetra. In 1988, John Keylock discovered this hybrid in calcareous grassland at Dolebury, the specimen determined by A.J. Silverside (Roe, 1989). More recently it has been found at Sand Point, in a disused quarry at Cross, growing with both parents, at five sites within the Cheddar Complex SSSI, and at Ubley Hill, to the NE of Cheddar Gorge, all identifications determined or confirmed by Chris Metherell. This hybrid is distributed along the coast of western Britain, from southwest England to southwest Scotland; Somerset sites fall within this range.
