Nardus stricta L.

Mat-grass

Native

GB: Least Concern

England: Near Threatened VC5 Not Scarce; VC6 Scarce


A densely tufted perennial grass of infertile acidic soils on heaths and moors. In VC5 this species is common on Exmoor and the Quantocks. It appears to have declined in the east part of Exmoor and on the Brendons, and has only a few recent records on the Blackdowns. In 2000, Mat-grass was found at Ash Priors Common (ST152288), but there have been no subsequent records for that site. In VC6 this species has always been scarce. White (1912) listed three sites: boggy moorland on Black Down, where it is still to be found; near the Mineries on Mendip and on the boggy margins of a stream between the Tan-pits and Failand Farm. In 1994 it was recorded during a survey of Chancellor's Farm (ST5252), northeast of Priddy Mineries, but it has not been seen there subsequently. There are no recent records for the Failand area. Marshall (1914) included a record for Shapwick by W. Watson: there have been no other records for the Peat Moors. Away from Black Down, this species is now only known at a few other scattered sites on the Mendips, where the Old Red Sandstone outcrops, and on the Lower Greensand in the east of VC6 where it has only recently been recorded in one field. *Nardus stricta* has declined in lowland Britain due to loss of habitat; in Somerset this species appears to have been lost from several sites.
